2. Entry fees: \$150/entry/test. Make checks payable to Kansas State University, or <https://commerce.cashnet.com/AGRONKSU> Crop Performance Testing Fees
3. Entries close **April 29, 2024**.
4. Mail or ship prepaid 1 lb of seed/entry/test for oil-type entries and 1.5 lb of seed/entry/test for confectionary-type entries. Seed shall be of a high quality with good germination. Seed should reach Kansas State University **no later than May 1, 2024**. Planting plans will be firmed on **May 2, 2024** to include only those entries for which seed and payment have been received, unless prior arrangements have been made. Seed of a hybrid may be sent in bulk for all locations.
5. Promising experimental hybrids near the point of being considered for release will be accepted as space permits. Mark experimental hybrids clearly (Exp.) on entry form.
6. If entering a newly named hybrid that was previously tested as an experimental number, please indicate the experimental number.

SUBMISSION OF ALL FORMS INDICATED IS REQUIRED.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

1. The 2024 sunflower performance tests will each have four replications in a randomized, complete-block design.
2. Reports will be furnished to cooperators as soon as possible after harvest.
